No:PSP-2004/Cr-25/Road-8. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1-A), (1-B), (1-C), (1-D) and (1-E) of section 20 of the Bombay Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1958 (Bom LXV of 1958), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf the Government of Maharashtra hereby declares that toll shall be levied on the classes of motor vehicles specified in the column (2) of the Schedule appended hereto, and on the trailers drawn by such vehicles, passing through any of newly constructed flyover bridges, railway over bridges or roads constructed, re-constructed, improved or repaired, as the case may be, the cluster which is situated within the Aurangabad city (more particularly described in the Note Below), which is hereby declared as one single entity for the purposes of the said section 20, at the rates specified against each of the said vehicles in column (3) of the said Schedule, from 1st April, 2013 to 31st March, 2015 at each of the following Toll Collection centres.

- (a) Near Sawangi Village on Aurangabad Jalgaon Road Major State Highway Number 8 at Kilometer 238/700.
- (b) Near Nakshatrawadi village on Aurangabad Paithan Road, State Highway Number 30 at Kilometer 336/800
- (c) Near Lasur village on Aurangabad Lasur Road State Highway Number 30.



Notes :

1. The cluster of the Roads and Bridges shall include the construction of Flyover Bridges in Aurangabad city; construction of ROB's at Ladgaon on Jalna Road, Zalta Bypass, near Shivajinagar and Sangramnagar on Beed Bypass Road and Ahmednagar Naka, Four laning of Shendra Industrial area to Chikalhana and Zalta diversion; Service Road to Beed Bypass Road, construction of Paithan Link Road joining Aurangabad- Paithan Road and Aurangabad Ahemadnagar Road; construction of Road Aurangabad – Ahemadnagar Highway to Tisgaon- Lasur Station Road; Improvement (to national highway standard) of Aurangabad Paithan Road; and providing hard shoulders to Gangapur phata to Waluj.
2. A vehicle owner who purchases a toll coupon book in advance containing 50 or 100 coupons, will be given a discount of 25 per cent and 50 per cent respectively.
3. The following types of vehicles are exempted from payment of toll namely :-
 1. VVIP Vehicle carrying President of India and Vice President of India, Governor of States, Public Representatives entitled for Red Lamp on vehicle.
 2. Vehicle carrying sitting Member of Parliament, Maharashtra Legislative Assembly and Maharashtra Legislative Council.
 3. Vehicle carrying Ex-Member of Parliament from Maharashtra and Ex-Member of Maharashtra Legislative Assembly and Maharashtra Legislative Council.
 4. Government Vehicles.
 5. Defence Vehicles
 6. Police Vehicles.
 7. Fire Fighting Vehicles
 8. Ambulances.
 9. Hearses.
 10. Vehicles of Posts and Telegraphs Department.
4. For this purpose, the Maharashtra State Road Development Corporation Ltd., Mumbai, is authorised to collect and retain the amount of toll at the above toll collection centres,
